## OHIO PAIN & REHABILITATION IN WARREN ADDS NEW PHYSICAL THERAPY MACHINE

Warren, Ohio – June 8, 2021 – Ohio Pain & Rehabilitation, a chiropractic and physical therapy center in Warren, announces the addition of a new physical therapy machine called the Indiba Active CT9.

The Indiba Active CT9 utilizes an electromagnetic wave at a frequency of 448 kHz to reduce pain and swelling, improve mobility, and enable faster healing. The device converts electrical current into a fixed stable frequency of 448 kHz, increasing ionic exchange at a cellular level which encourages tissue repair and assists in pain management.

It can treat the following musculoskeletal conditions; osteoarthritis, lower back pain, neck pain, bursitis, tendinopathy, hematoma, fractures, muscle tears, sprains and strains. The Indiba device also can enhance physio aesthetics including skin trophicity, scars, edemas, contouring of sagging skin, as well as lymphatic and venous drainage.
